**1. Call to order**

Superintendent Stevens called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

**2. Review science curriculum**

Director of Curriculum and Instruction, Dr. Conley, reviewed the calendar of curriculum committee meetings. She reviewed the scope and sequence of the science curriculum, K-8. Dr. Conley reviewed the temporary usage of mystery science, which is aligned with NGSS, until the elementary approval of the open science curriculum, an open use curriculum. She shared the layout of the science curriculum and examples of lessons. Katie Rychling reviewed her experiences with the curriculum and how impactful it has been with her students. Committee members stated the importance of sharing how different teaching and learning of science is now compared to prior years. Dr. Conley shared some sample assessments. Katie Rychling shared the importance of maintaining the Gizmos subscription, ordering supply kits, and providing professional development for teachers to learn the proper methods to implement the curriculum. The committee felt they would be prepared to make a recommendation for the grades 5 through 8 science curriculum following their December curriculum meeting. The committee discussed non-fiction reading in the curriculum.
